Dear Mr. Weisberg:

Reference is made to your appeal of the Dallas and New Orleans Field Office files concerning the assassination of President John F. Kennedy.

Enclosed are 53 pages of material, 33 pages of which have never been released, which were referred to other government agencies for consultation. Also enclosed are the inventory worksheets which reflect the changes made to these documents.

Excisions have been made in these documents in order to protect materials which are exempted from disclosure pursuant to the following subsections of Title 5, United States Code, Section 552:

- (b) (2) materials related solely to the internal rules and practices of the FBI;
- (b) (6) materials contained in sensitive records such as personnel or medical files, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy;
- (b) (7) investigatory records compiled for law enforcement purposes, the disclosure of which would:

- (C) constitute an unwarranted invasion of the personal privacy of another person;
- (D) reveal the identity of an individual who has furnished information to the FBI under confidential circumstances or reveal information furnished only by such a person and not apparently known to the public or otherwise accessible to the FBI by overt means.
