Re Mark's No. 234,044, FBI's letter of 1/9/84:

Rephrase the request to keep them out of all the main files and see refs they can think of to run Mark's costs up. Something like asking for any existing list of them, those processed and those ignored, handled by the FOIPA branch, etc.

They don't have to go to central indices for a search of their own working records and no professional time would be involved.

Unless Mark has some special purpose in beginning 1/1/78 I'd leave that out and I'd assume that the request includes all as of the time of receipt by the FBI.

After he sees this he can decide if he needs more or if they have more.

That way he'd also be in a position to learn what was disclosed.
