Throughout 62-109090, which is a Commission file, there is substitution for records annotated by the Director. I attach as an illustration the Not Recorded Serial of 1/21/64, Malley to Rosen.

It is apparent that the notations are not in the Director's distinctive handwriting.

His comments, opinions and directives are all of considerable historical significance.

There appears to be no reason why these copies could not have been zeroxes of the actual record he read and annotated. That is normal practise with other records and copies.

Of course I have a separate interest in what is not undeviating FMI practice now, "We should not be reluctance to making anything available at any time or place."
