

To Quia Shea from Harold Weisberg, JFK & King assassination records appeals 12/24/80
Oswald-Mexico (Epstein request)
Records of Divisions- need to search (includes Dallas records)(practise
pertinent in King case, C.A. 75-1996)

Attached are 105-3702- 138? and 139?, both from the Mexico City Legat's "Oswald" file. The last digit of the serial of the first is eliminated in xeroxing, that of the second partially eliminated.

Both of these records related to FOIA requests, although 139? does not so state, but in neither case is the usual FOIA response requested. Both records bear on the need to search the records of the Divisions, which, pretendedly, do not exist, for real compliance in both cases.

Response in the Epstein matter (subject of a separate request and pertinent in both Dallas and FBIHQ cases) is directed to the ~~xxxxxxxx~~ renamed "Crimes Records" operation, "External Affairs." That to the Fensterwald request is to be made to the Domestic Intelligence Division.

They^s also pertain to Oswald in Mexico, the subject of separate requests and appeals, and in particular to whether or not Dallas has provided all it can. In this connection, while the language is ambiguous, 138? appears to state that when SA Eldon Rudd flew to Dallas from Mexico City he had 20 photographs with him. (To the best of my recollection all these have not/been provided by Dallas or FBIHQ. Some were~~g~~ provided to Fensterwald in his FOIA litigation.)

Names disclosed in these records, none not previously known, are also withheld in HQ and Dallas records, which I did appeal.
