I got up earlier than the usual early to complete the reading of the book and to write Shea. I have read all but the appendix and the index. I include a couple of illustrations of the use of index to argue so I'll read it. I'll be writing further about other aspects when there is time.

For now there is what I regard as essential and perhaps enough for a turnaround in No. 77-1831 and the 6/23/78 transcript.

Please turn to page 271 and read this for yourself.

Nosenko was told by the CIA not to talk to any "unauthorized" person.

This means that both Barron and Epstein were authorized, his abiding by the conditions of the agreement being a requisite of the CIA's performance on that agreement.

There are other details at this point.

~~It~~ also that I saw no mention of what Nosenko told the FBI, that the KGB regarded LHO as an American sleeper agent.

I believe that this exemplifies the CIA's misuse of the statutes for political purposes and for propaganda rather than for the serious purposes of the statutes. They have claimed the statutes to withhold/ from me while they disclose more to Epstein.
