

JFK assassination records appeals  
Withholding the reasonably segregable  
- (7)(D) claims

Originally the Not Recorded serial after 262 in 62-109090 was gone to be released in full. This is visible on the worksheet. This was changed and the entire record was withheld under (7)(D) claim. It is an internal record, described as "Memo to Sullivan." It therefore appears unlikely that either a confidential source or an only source wrote the memo. It also appears to be entirely unlikely that nothing was reasonably segregable or that the analyst would have erred so greatly as to disclose all of two pages when all of two pages is properly withheld.

The time is immediately after publication of the Warren Report, 10/2/64.

This is a Commission file, the only one the FBI disclosed while withholding the fact that it had other Commission files.
