Bishop Pike, the is under investigation by an Episcopal Church committee for possible heresy charges, de-clared that "the most important thing in the long Jun is the truth," and that even if "our image abroad" suffers, the facts should be

known.

Keating's San Franciscobased magazine is running articles in its current issue about violent deaths of 10 persons who could have been linked in the assassination. He said 90 per cent of evidence gathered by the CIA and 50 per cent of that gathered by the PBI has not been released. However, he suggested that the "most eritical suppressed evidence" is a color movie of the assassination taken by a Dallas amateur photographer and the 40 autopsy photographs and X-rays of Kennedy's body.
