

JFK assassination records appeals

Exemptions claimed - in the alternative only
Withholding the reasonably segregable

Examination of the HQ to New Orleans airtel of 12/12/67, Not Recorded in 62-109060, attached, discloses that although the entire text is withheld it appears certain that at least a few words are reasonably segregable and could be disclosed.

Examination of the worksheets discloses much more. This is another one of those FBI FOIA b2 "highs." So high that from the worksheets there is an additional two pages that are not accounted for in what was provided.

The exemptions claimed for the one obliterated page reads "b7D or high b2."

This is what I mean by claiming exemptions in the alternative.

It also would appear to be impossible for any record in any way relating to the assassination of the investigation could possibly meet the "solely" standard of the exemption.

It would also appear that the appropriate exemption is 'D, is b2 or is both, not either.

No claim to exemption is posted on the records itself, the flaw permeating all records in the general releases. This serves only to impede checking on the FBI.

Particularly because two entire pages recorded on the worksheets are not in what is disclosed Ms. Darrett made an effort to cross check with the New Orleans records. She could not locate or identify, even as #previously processed, any copy of this record.
