Having ordeined a single assassin and no conspiracy, the government holds that anything indicating Oswald was not the assassin or that there was, indeed, a conpairacy, has "no significant connection with the assassination of the President." Furthermore, this is an irrelevant test, one that finds no authorization in the law, and was not the test of the Presidential Commission, by its standard, what might have had any connection with the accused assassin or those allegedly connected with him in any was proper ground for inquiry.

In any event, this determination, under the law, is not for the Government to make. In signing the law, President Johnson put it very well, in these words: "I have always believed that freedom of information is so vital that only the national security, not the desire of public officials or private citizens, should determine when it must be restricted."

The cannot apply to Ferrie's connection with clandestine Čuban activities, especially because the Commission itself conducted investigations in this area. It cannot apply to reports disclosing evidence that, contrary to Defendant Department of Justice's protestation, is not in the Wargen Commission files and is of such a nature as to embarrass the government and expose the predetermined, inadequate character of what was supposed to have been a complete and impartial investigation.
