Field office files

Dallas appears not to have started its Warren Commission file, 62-3526, until several days after the official life of the Commission ended. This leads to the belief that Dallas filed its Commission records in a different file.

Attached are Serials 8 and 37 of the 62-3526 file. Both refer to the existence of a special index, to the Warren Report. (The FBI sometime used this reference to include the appended volumes. The delay in sending out copies of this special index leads to the belief that the single volume of the Report is not all that the FBI indexed. That could have been done three months earlier.)

Serial 8, of several days after the printed Report was out, states that according to Inspector Malley the Report "is being indexed at the SOA."

Serial 37 discloses the sending of copies of this index under date of 12/7/64.

New Orleans neither provided any copy of this index nor claimed it had been previously processed, as it was not. (Neither did Dallas.)

That this index does not duplicate the one published in the Report is apparent from the dates. Serial 8 is of five days after page proofs of the indexed Report were available, two days after official release of the printed and bound Report.
