Re Bureau telephone call to SAC Gillies 12/20/63.

As you have been previously advised, a Presidential Commission has been formed to conduct inquiry into the assassination of President John F. Kennedy. Chief Justice Earl Warren is chairman of this commission.

It has been brought to the Bureau's attention that there are possibly a number of individuals who would like to see physical harm come to Chief Justice Warren. While the Bureau has no investigative jurisdiction involving the protection of Mr. Warren, you are instructed to be alert for any information indicating antipathy toward him and any such information received should be immediately brought to the attention of the Bureau.

Appropriate personnel of your office should be so advised.
