The original of a not recorded serial of 6/5/69 in 62-109060 is in a file the number of which is not legible on the copy provided to me. While the caption alleges a civil rights violation by a prisoner, John W. Cancler, the "ew "riesns number, 62-4104 (C) is not a Civil Rights number or file. In fact this is a Carrison record, Jin Carrison allegedly violating Cancler's rights.

On the first page one paragraph begins, "Mr. Cample? furnished information regarding an alleged harcotics dealer in New Orleans, ba., ..." In this case the possibility of hors to Canclar is real if his information was real and identified a person by mase as a narcotics dealer. This is not the only such case but at the esme time the FMI extensively withholds the names of non-confidential sources where there is not there expressed nor implied confidentiality.

Ganoler, also known as "John The Saptist," as this record does not indicate, was an experienced burglar who apparently invented a story that some of the regular New Orleans police assigned to "arrison's office as inventigators promised him something if instead of burglarizing Clay-Shaw's home planted some incriminating evidence there. The story was spread by lawyers representing clients in whom Carrison had an interest. It was told to me by three reporters in april 1967, ain New Orleans. Thereafter it was published.

In the past I have called to your attention several unsearched Garrison files.

These files also hold Garrison information, perhaps information not otherwise disclosed by FBIEG or in my C.A. 78-0322.
