

Files not searched  
Oswald as FBI informer?

While to err is human - even for those who designate where FBI records will be filed - there is too much that appears to be unusual about 62-109090-83, of which the first page only is attached.

All relevant files have not been searched.

There is a departure from consistent FBI practise in not filing a copy in the 67 file, Henry Wade being a former SA. (Interestingly enough the records I've seen refer to his foreign duty only.)

Copies are designated for the Ruby and Oswald files but not for the assassination file, again unusual.

With 62-87096 and 94-8-75 both relevant and unrecorded copies made for both files no records from either file have been provided.

Dallas

Wade was ~~Wade's~~ District Attorney and Dallas records are in litigation.

On this aspect and on much of the investigation the FBI's media operations are of great historical importance. The 94 filing indicates such an involvement.

What had the FBI and the Commission in a tizzy is the report that Oswald had been an FBI informant, certainly a matter of great historical interest.
