This amplified prior appeals relating to withholding of information on the claimed "national security" need not to disclose foreign operations that in fact have never been secret and have regularly been ~~is~~ "disclosed" by the FBI itself. In particular this adds to yesterday's appeal.

Attached is 105-82555-3731, from Legat, Mexico. Please note that on the second page language originally marked for excision is not excised, which represents a conscious (and proper) decision. What was not excised refers to the FBI's Mexican operations and "investigative activities by Bureau personnel therein."

This is quite opposite FBI sworn representations in both cases and entirely supports my affidavits in them. It/also relates to your affidavit in C.A. 78-0249, in which, by foundabout means, you undertook to lead that court to believe that information like the above is properly withheld.

This record~~s~~ refers to an attachment that isn't present, a very common practise in these files. What makes the absence of these attachment less easy to understand is that they were attached to the recorded copies, where they belong.

I have come across numerous duplicate copies of the same record and found that the attachment~~s~~ was missing from all of them.
