

JFK - JFR estate letter agreement (autopsy materials, etc)

To Gain them from David Weisberg, JFK and RF records as well 6/15/80
Original and Civil Division/ CIA

With this I provide a copy of the cited Civil Division letter and my response, which I intend also as an appeal. Also with this is a separate appeal relating to records on and about me not provided under my RF request or appeal, copies of some of which are in the Department's 128-11 file. If you do not find both self-explanatory please let me know.

Initially the letter agreement between the ^{representative of the} executor of the JFK estate and CIA was withheld. Thereafter I never obtained a clear copy. Despite other requests that include it a clear copy was not provided later. The Civil files reflect that the original, and I presume other pertinent records, are in CIA. These other records have not yet been provided in any form. They are all of great historical importance and I would like copies, please.

Several quite interest records pertaining to David W. Ferris are included in the 6/10 mailing. David Ferris, deceased in 1967, is within C.A. 75-3322. Until I obtained these Civil Division records I could do no more than allege the belief that because Ferris was in the Federal courtroom on 11/22/63, when Carlos Marcello was on trial, there should be other records not provided. These records leave no doubt that others must exist and can be retrieved with no difficulty. Ferris was defense investigator in the Marcello case.

In my letter to Mr. Mackey I refer to the litigation involving the CIA- David Marshall letter agreement and autopsy-related materials and records. I have personal knowledge covering time of participation in that case until the lunch recess, when I separated myself from it. Civil Division has important records pertaining to that matter. If Carl Gering or Irving Saffir left any separate records they should be searched. Any H.Q. FBI records also are pertinent and within my request.
