Attached teletype reports highly unusual situation wherein someone reportedly has contacted Random House Publishing Company, New York City, in an effort to obtain information regarding Richard J. Eorger, a former employee of the New Orleans Office. Random House official informed New York Office that a person identifying Limself as Special Agent Jack Gilbert of ti: New Orleans Office requested information concerning Berger be furnished Cilbert at phone number listed to New Orleans Office. Earger was employed as a file clork by New Orleans Office 11-6-63 and rusigned such position effective 10-15-65 Las services were satisfactory. SA Gilbett "...o is assigned to the Monroe, Louisiana, Lesident Agency, states he did not place call to Random House and could shed no light on matter. Berger's present location Inasmuch as New Orleans' District I T. TOTT. Attorney Garrison and his staff reportedly are seeking out disgruntled former FBI personnel to interview, this may be part cr Garrison's activity. We are contacting Random House to get added details regarding this matter and are advising Special Agent in Charge, New Orleans, to take immediate steps to contact telephone company to make certain New Orleans Office telephone lines secure. This matter is being closely iciloved and you will be kept advised.
