INDEX CHECK BY NEW ORLEANS REVEALED THAT RICHARD BERGER, BUFILE 67-69892, HAD BEEN A CLIENT OF THE NEW ORLEANS DIVISION. ^{Richard J. BERGEN} _{former client} THE PERSONNEL FILE BEARING HAS BEEN SENT TO THE BUREAU. *LC*

ON THE SAME DATE, SPECIAL AGENT JOHN P. SILBERT OF THE NEW ORLEANS RESIDENT AGENCY, WAS CONTACTED AT TALLULA, LOUISIANA. SILBERT ADVISED THAT HE HAD NOT PLACED A TELEPHONE CALL TO RANDOM HOUSE WHEN NO INDIVIDUAL NAMED RICHARD BERGER HAD BEEN MENTIONED IN THE TELEPHONE CALL TO RANDOM HOUSE.

ON FEBRUARY 8, INSTANT, SPECIAL AGENT ILLIUS WAS CONTACTED AT NEW YORK BUT COULD FURNISH NO ADDITIONAL INFORMATION RELATIVE TO TELEPHONE CALL TO RANDOM HOUSE.

IT IS THE OPINION OF THE NEW ORLEANS OFFICE THAT INSTANT TELEPHONE CALL MAY HAVE BEEN MADE BY A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE ATTORNEY JAMES GARRISON, II. THAT GARRISON IS
