Reference Los Angeles teletype to Bureau, Miami, Phoenix and Dallas, 9/17/64, setting out interview of LORAN HALL on 9/16/64; Phoenix teletype to Bureau, Los Angeles, Dallas and Miami, 9/18/64 setting out interview of WILLIAM SEYMOUR; Los Angeles teletype to Bureau, Dallas and Miami, 9.21/64 containing interview of LAWRENCE HOWARD.

Enclosed for the Bureau are 9 copies of LHM dated and captioned as above. Two copies of the LHM and an Immigration and Naturalization Service photograph of CELIO CASTRO, taken in November, 1961, are enclosed to the Dallas Office.

CELIO CASTRO advised that the American woman with the 17 year old daughter, who was visited in Dallas by HALL, HOWARD and CASTRO, is a friend of JERRY PATRICK. JERRY PATRICK is identical with GERALD PATRICK HEMMING, an American who has been involved in Cuban revolutionary activity at Miami. The Miami Office will interview PATRICK in an effort to determine the contacts of HALL and HOWARD while at Dallas, Texas during September, 1963, in particular the identity of the American woman with the 17 year old daughter, the American employed in a Dallas bank with whom HALL and HOWARD left the trailer containing equipment, and the identity of the Cuban woman whom HALL and HOWARD attempted to contact during an afternoon visit but who was not home at the time.
