Odio at her apartment in late September and then recanted. We are endeavoring to disprove Odio's statements. Neunson is an SI subject of Newark Office who lived in Russia from 1922 to 1940 and has a wife and three children there. After assassination he wrote letter in Russian to Marina sending same to Ruth Paine who forwarded it to Marina. Neunson offered to be of assistance to Marina and told her that his son Edward in Russia had met her. Prior to interviewing Neunson we want to see his letter to Marina. Marina is now in Santa Fe assisting in the preparation of a book being written by Priscilla Johnson. She states she may have letter in question in her home in Richardson or that Declan Ford may have it. While she has given written permission for us: to enter her home, Dallas recommends against this and in view of circumstances, we agree. There is no foreseeable objection to obtaining letter from Ford if he has it.
