Mr. dus-Bolz, Identification Division was telephonically alerted by SA J. A. Conley on 11/22/63 possibility that the gun believed to have been used to kill the President may be brought to the Bureau by an Agent of the Dallas Office requiring latent fingerprint examination. Bolz stated he would have personnel available in latent fingerprint section on Saturday to handle any examination.

Pobert A. Frazier and Charles L. Killion of the Laboratory will conduct the firearms examination when the gun is received and will also examine the bullets. They have been advised on the evening of 11/22/63 that one bullet found on the stretcher by hospital attendant in Dallas is being turned over to an Agent from EFO on 11/22/63 for delivery to the Laboratory.
