
Mr. O. P. WRIGHT, Security Officer, Parkland Hospital, advised that he had a piece of paper which reflected several names and what appeared to be racial information contained within the writing. He desired that this be secured from him. He advised he would be at the hospital this evening for awhile; however, when the agent calls, that this piece of paper could be obtained from Mr. DUTTON, the Night Administrator, Parkland Hospital.

According to Mr. WRIGHT, this piece of paper was found near the scene where reporters were preparing notes, and it could very well be that this was dropped by one of the reporters; however, he desired only to make it available to the FBI. He was advised an agent would stop by and pick it up.
