Dear Mr. Weisberg:

Reference is made to your Freedom of Information-Privacy Acts request for materials on the assassination of President John F. Kennedy.

Enclosed is one copy of documents contained in Dallas file 67-425, pertaining to personnel matters. One hundred fifteen of 115 pages are being released. A copy of the inventory worksheets is also enclosed.

Where noted on the enclosed documents, excisions have been made in order to protect materials which are exempted from disclosure by the following subsections of Title 5, United States Code, Section 552:

- (b) (1) information which is currently and properly classified pursuant to Executive Order 12065 in the interest of the national defense or foreign policy;
- (b) (2) materials related solely to the internal rules and practices of the FBI;
- (b) (6) materials contained in sensitive records such as personnel or medical files, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy;

- (b) (7) investigatory records compiled for law enforcement purposes, the disclosure of which would:
- (D) reveal the identity of an individual who has furnished information to the FBI under confidential circumstances or reveal information furnished only by such a person and not apparently known to the public or otherwise accessible to the FBI by overt means;
 - (E) disclose investigative techniques and procedures, thereby impairing their future effectiveness.

Portions of two documents have been referred to the Central Intelligence Agency for their review. Upon return of these documents a supplemental release will be made, if appropriate.
