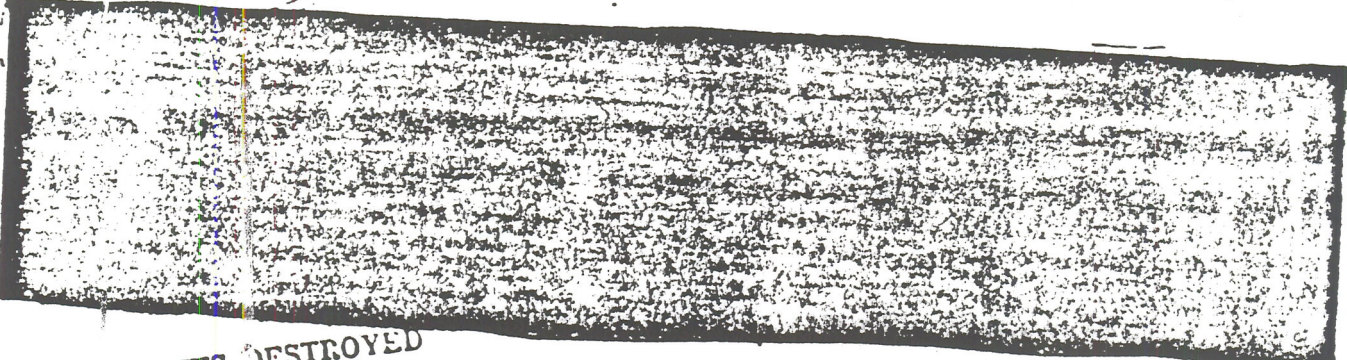

Dallas, Texas

On November 25, 1963, Mr. DAN SANBORN, Sanborn
Travel Agency, McAllen, Texas, advised he had been checking
records of Mexican automobile insurance policies sold
by his firm during recent weeks through his McAllen,
Brownsville, and Laredo, Texas offices.

In this connection he had ascertained that
one ANTHONY W. OSWALD, 66 Interpark Avenue, Buffalo, 11,
New York, had purchased a three day policy at the McAllen,
Texas office of the Sanborn Travel Agency at 4:00 p.m.,
September 27, 1963, covering a 1962 Pontiac two door
automobile, Identification Number 162P51856. This policy
would expire at 4:00 p.m., September 30, 1963. His records
did not contain a license number for the Pontiac automobile.

On November 25, 1963, it was determined that
this automobile did not enter Mexico at Reynosa, Tamaulipas,
Mexico.

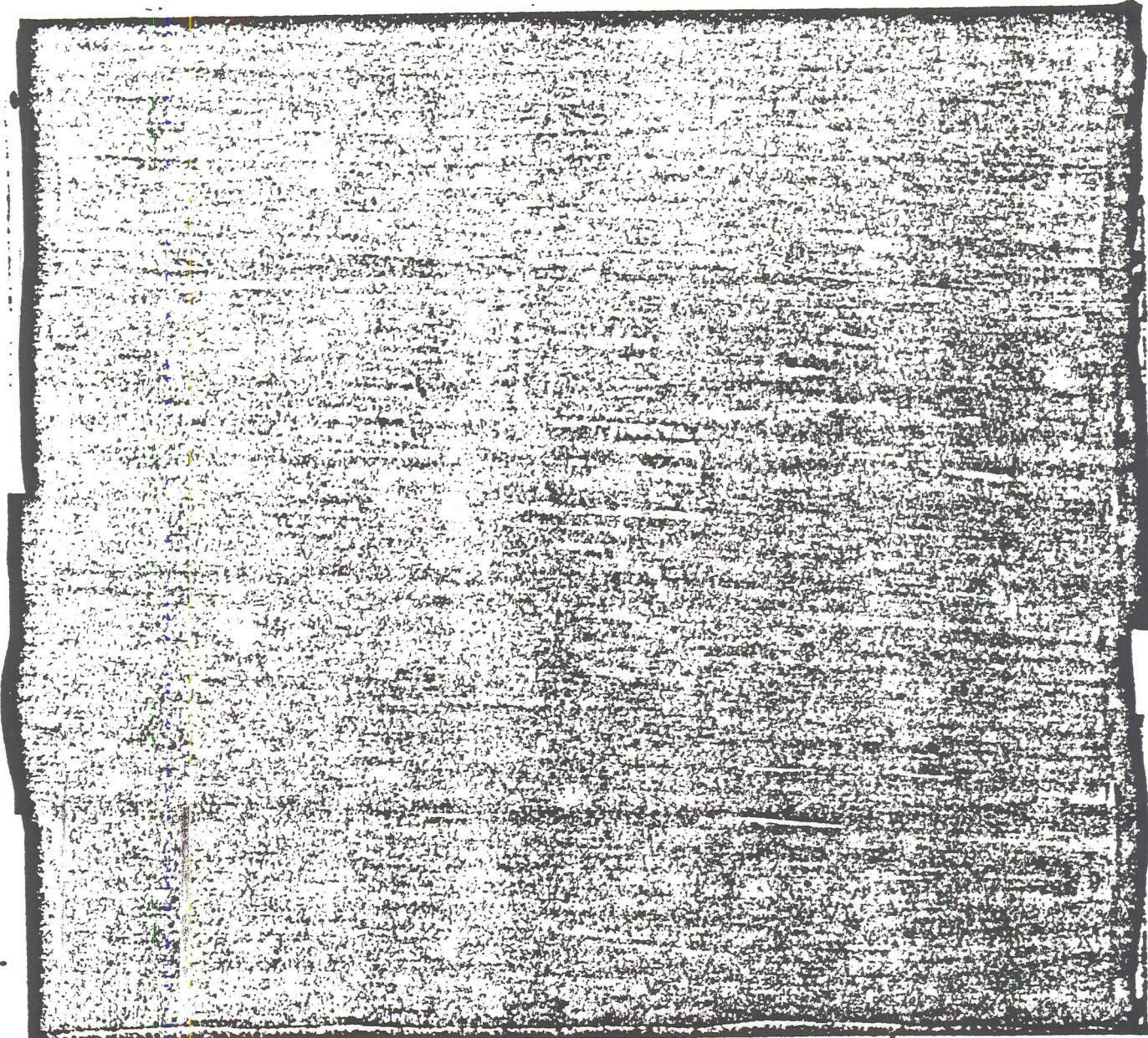

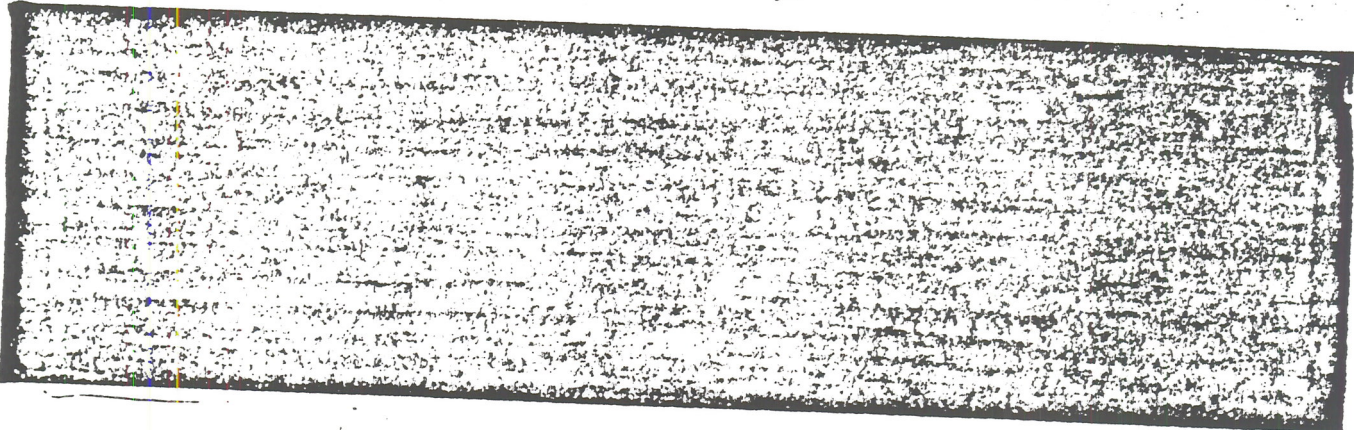
