Dear Mr. Weisberg:

Enclosed are 1,514 pages of the Dallas Field Office Communications Index concerning the assassination of President John F. Kennedy.

Excisions have been made from these documents in order to protect materials which are exempted from disclosure by the following subsections of Title 5, United States Code, Section 552:

- (b) (1) information which is currently and properly classified pursuant to Executive Order 12065 in the interest of the national defense or foreign policy.
- (b) (2) materials related solely to the internal rules and practices of the FBI.
- (b) (6) materials contained in sensitive records such as personnel or medical files, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy
- (b) (7) investigatory records compiled for law enforcement purposes, the disclosure of which would:
 - (C) constitute an unwarranted invasion of the personal privacy of another person;

(D) reveal the identity of an individual who has furnished information to the FBI under confidential circumstances or reveal information furnished only by such a person and not apparently known to the public or otherwise accessible to the FBI by overt means.

There have been no pages withheld in their entirety from this material.

Information originating with other government agencies has been excised from these documents pending notification from each respective agency as to the releasability of that information. Once a determination has been made, you will be advised accordingly.

In regard to your request for the Dallas Field Office 3 X 5 index cards, they are currently being processed and you will be notified upon the completion of the processing.

In conjunciton with the processing of the 3 X 5 index, we will prepare a cross-reference index listing the documents in the Dallas Field Office files corresponding to those found in the FBI Headquarters files. This is being done to facilitate the use of the 3 X 5 index with the FBI Headquarters material that is already in your possession.
