To Quin Shea from Harold Weisberg, JEW assessination records appeals 6/21/79 previously processed indices missing attachments

The 12/13/53 Director to Dallas AIRTEL attached, 165-62555-564 refers to attachments that were not attached to the copy provided to me. By means of these copies the Dallas office, which received them, was directed to undertake certain investigations and to file reports as expeditiously as possible.

If in precessing the Pallas records the copies that reached Pallas were indicated as prejoughly processed they would in fact have been withhold from me from all files.

(This would also be true if I were now given the PRIEQ citation in explanation for any Dallas withholding.)

Except in the event the FSI managed to avoid getting the same records that had been provided by local Texas authorities to the Secret Service, in which event the FRI's purpose would be to stall or frustrate compliance, there appears to be no need to make referral to the Secret Service.

That a set of "the actual documents" existed in Washington is established in the appended note.

That/there also is an FBIRQ index not provided to me is also indicated in this same note.
