King and JFK assassination records appeals

It has been the FBI's claim, which I have never believed, that the Lab has no files of its own and that all its records are in Central Records. This is my understanding of the recent testimony on deposition by SA John Kilty. As I have come to proofs to the contrary, sometimes from the FBI's own records and publications, I have provided you with proof that the various Division in fact have their own files. My related appeals have not been acted on. This means that the relevant records in the various cases on both broad subjects remain withheld.

In Section 157 of 62-109060 as provided to me there were four loose sheets that were stapled together. They appear to represent what was intended to be the representation of a bulky from the first of these stapled pages, indicated as 6339. These stapled pages were not in substitutions for 6339, nor were they at the exact point where 6339 appears. At that point in the bound Section there is the second of the stapled pages only, apparently identical with it except for the barely legible notation that the RRF was created on 8/16/68.

Although on earlier occasions the stapled-together pages had been punched for binding the copies provided loosely to me are not punched. I presume this is an accident. I regard it as a fortunate accident because of a notation on the fourth page, a copy of which I attach.

Under the identification of "Bufile ~~62-109060~~ 62-109060" there appears the identification "Lab. file E-568-J2." This is followed by "Lab. Report 4/18/68" and a brief description of the magnetic tape recording identified as Q-1.

I believe this constitutes proof that the Lab in fact does have and preserve its own files, contrary to the Kilty testimony and all other representations made in all cases by the FBI. This also means that there has been a deliberate refusal to search the Lab files for compliance.

While I do not know what was eliminated by way of Lab identifications from records provided to me in C.A. 75-1996, such information is a ^{clear} ~~clear~~ possibility. I appealed it.
