REBUTEL TO ALL SACS JULY 28, 1976.

FURTHER DISCUSSIONS WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE TASK FORCE HAS RESULTED IN THE FOLLOWING CHANGE REGARDING REPRODUCTION OF FIELD OFFICE SERIALS IN THE MURKIN INVESTIGATION, AS OUTLINED IN REFERENCED TELETYPE.

IT WILL BE NECESSARY ONLY TO XEROX THE FIRST PAGE OF ANY DOCUMENT IN YOUR MURKIN FILE IF A COPY OF THAT DOCUMENT HAS BEEN SUBMITTED TO FBIHQ. THIS WILL INCLUDE BOTH DOCUMENTS ORIGINATING IN YOUR OFFICE AND THOSE RECEIVED FROM OTHER FIELD DIVISIONS. ANY DOCUMENTS IN YOUR MURKIN FILE, COPIES OF WHICH HAVE NOT BEEN SUBMITTED TO FBIHQ MUST BE REPRODUCED IN THEIR ENTIRETY AND FORWARDED TO FBIHQ.

NOTE:

Referenced teletype instructed all offices, except those to be visited by the Department Task Force, to xerox serials in its Murkin investigation and forward to FBIHQ by 8/9/76. The Department has requested Murkin files to continue its review as directed by the Attorney General.

Since the Task Force has reviewed Murkin files at FBIHQ duplication can be avoided by having the field office xerox only the first page of serials in cases where a copy of that serial was furnished FBIHQ. This procedure has been coordinated with Fred Folsom, Office of Professional Responsibility Department of Justice, who is leader of the Task Force.
