This is in reference to the attached memorandum from Henry S. Dogin, Acting Administrator, Drug Enforcement Administration. That memorandum reports information which may be pertinent to the FBI's administrative inquiry, currently in progress, into the conduct of Bureau employees in connection with the alleged destruction of a note to the FBI from Lee Harvey Oswald prior to the murder of President John F. Kennedy in 1963.
