King and JPK assassination records again

During the recent depositions in C.A. 75-1996 there was a not atypical failure of FBI recall, relating to the June/ June Mail/and transfers to June files of records that had originally been in the "main" file. Consistent with this was a lack of recollection of the Records Branch's "Special File Room." This is not at all surprising, given the fact that the FBI has a special form for such transfers.

It is not possible for me to now review the 20,000 or so pages of WILKIN Bureau records that I read years ago. However, I am going over JPK records, in particular the "Osvaldo" or 105-82555 file. I find that the same form is used in this file. Some times there are no obliterations on the form, sometimes the word "Mail" is erased, leaving "June," and as with attached sheets from Serials 2401 and 2403, neither word remains. (after "Subject.")

I select these two as illustrative because in the set of ~~records~~ provided to me there are no copies of Serials 2400 or 2402 and no sheets reflecting any transfer of them.

I am certain that in the past I provided you with an adequate number of copies of this "permanent charge out" sheet as parts of appeals on which you have not acted.

"June" is a reference to surveillances. In C.A. 75-1996 I am to have received all copies of all WILKIN records and there are surveillance items of the requests that have not been complied with and can't be without searches of all records relating to all forms of surveillance. There was no search of any "June" records and no ~~any~~ search of the Records Branch's "Special File Room."
