On page 6, after enticipated consequences are stated in general, there are such specifice as carital difficulties, cental allment, Communist membership and "publication of the WFO airtel of 11-29-63, in light of the current Congressional interest in sail covers could well result in criticism of the Post Office Department and the loss of Post Office "epartment cooperation in highly delicate investigative techniques." This refers to covering the USSE embessy sail and picking up an Oswald letter, about which I have appealed in the past without acknowledgement.

Hoover's note is short and to the point: "I don't share your concerns about these matters."

The alleged privacy concerns did not deter publication by the Cormission, with FaI approval, and while the mail cover was not headlined, it also was not kept secret.
