Attached is a page from the worksheet~~s~~ covering the processing of 12 documents from Section 58 of the New Orleans assassination file, 89-43. The records of the period are of the Garrison period for the most part. Seven are of 5/5/67.

However, the other five are of 1963.

Yet they are serialized with these 1967 records. They are not referred to by earlier serial numbers or as serialized earlier, although they are withheld under the claim of having been previously processed.

As part of an historical record this is certain to confuse non-subject experts as well as some popularly considered to be subject experts. Particularly because the same information was never withheld in the Warren Commission files, as most people in the future will not know. And if they do not have copies of the worksheet scholars will be bewildered by November~~ber~~ 1973 records not being serialized until May 1967.

Not that the worksheet explains it.

No record I recall does explain it. I have reviewed enough records to know that this is not common FBI practise. From this I am led to believe that there should be a record explaining this and I appeal the withhold of it or then.
