

JFK assassination records appeals

Last September the CIA declassified a number of Nosenko records in connection with the inquiry before the House assassins committee. The day the Government's brief in the appeal from C.A. 75-1448 was due before the appeals court it claimed that the disclosure of two Warren Commission transcripts was required by this declassification and copies were provided to me.

However, the FBI did not provide any additional records or any without excisions because of this declassification nor did it provide copies of any records that might have been referred to the CIA.

At the time I probably assumed that with the concern for living within the laws that those of us who pay their salaries and other benefits have a right to expect of Government employees some of these would see to it that declassified information would be made available. While waiting for the bureaucracy to work I forgot about this until I had need to prepare another affidavit in C.A. 75-1448.

Since then I have filed Nosenko appeals. The FBI has not provided any additional records and the appeals have not been acted upon.
