Worth, Texas. [redacted] to defect to Russia in [redacted] 1959, and who was a member of the U. S. Marine LEAD Reserve, in 8-17-50 was given an undesirable discharge from the U. S. Marine Corps Reserve. His latest home NEW ORLEANS DIVISION, of 8-20-59, was listed as 3121 West [redacted] Ft. Worth, Texas.

She was then residing at 3330 West Sixth Street, Ft. Worth. She had been employed for two months as a saleslady at Clyde Campbell Company. She was a widow, and has another son, ROBERT L. ODUM, of 7300 Davenport Street, Ft. Worth. She had five accounts, all of which were satisfactory, except one rated a poor one. She did business at First National Bank of Ft. Worth. Previous addresses were listed as follows:
