

Dear Harold,

Thanks for your letters and the interesting enclosures. The 128 pp. from the Dallas FBI file, which you sent 4th class, nevertheless arrived yesterday! I haven't had time to do more than skim them, since I'm trying to get ready to go to Washington. I'll be leaving the 31st and arriving the 3rd, and expect to stay with Bud through the JFK hearings. I expect that things will be hectic, especially for the first few days of the hearings, but I'll get in touch with you as soon as I can.

Enclosed is my letter of 10/28/77 to the FBI, which I might have sent you before; it lists the files I knew were covered by my request for pre-ass'n FBI documents. So far, I've gotten stuff from DC, NY, and Dallas, but not N.O., and nothing from the Marina files as such; also, nothing from the minor files I specified. Also enclosed: Items #990-992, from the "Funds Transmitted" file, which the FBI might not have sent you yet. (My notes are included.) I suspect that the FBI's sensitive source was routine scrutiny of bank records which handled foreign exchange to the USSR.

Mark sent me the Mexico documents he got from your files. All very strange.

Your note of 8/2 asked for a memo you sent me some time ago on Veciana. I have no recollection of it, and couldn't find it in my Veciana-Odio file.
