Willies nonchester - JFK assassination interview with Hoover

This amplifies a prior appeal on which you have not so ted.

Sanchester was granted an interview with Hoover when preparing his book. On 3/24/67 H.A.Jones wrote a long memo about the book to Wick, 62-109060-5035. This is also indicated as filed in four other files the numbers of which are not completely legible. However, it is apparent that two are not the files from which HQ disclosed JFK assausination records. These two are 62 files. One appears to be 46855. The other is 11371. This one appears to be a main file because on page 7 citation is of it rather than an assausination file like 109060 or 109090. This is in connection with the Hoover interview, which was used as source material in the book.

Where the information withheld from an FOIA requester is in another and known FEI file and particularly where the information is what is disclosed by the Director or/relates to such disclosure I believe the information ought be disclosed to requesters, particularly in an historical case.

With particular reference to Manchester, who east himself as the official chronichler of his inspinary Camelot rather than as histories, full disclosure is even nour important because of his indical support by the Ausmedy family, the official favors granted his his exclusively (Mincluding an office in the archives), the later detechnant of the family and the grandens of his factual and political errors. Manchester was unfair to everyone, including the FEI and Secret Service.

(Contemporaneously I defended these assences through the print and electronic media.)

For these additional reasons there should be full disclosure of all files in any way relating to "enchanter and the information given to him. Without this full disclosure too historical disclosure is quite incompleted. In this connection please recall the extent of the pursonal and defaustory disclosures, without regard for PA when it was invoked, made by the FEI and the Department with regard to records relating to those the FEI does not love, like me.
