Dear Mr. Mitchell,

This is my appeal from your deputy's June 25 rejection of the request that letter cited from my letter of March 4, 1971.

I note that you note two things both of which I believe violate the law,
5 U.S.C. 552:

- a) Delay of more than three months in acting upon a request for public information; and
- b) The statement "that I cannot (legally) grant your request" because these allegedly are "Investigatory files compiled for law enforcement purposes..."

The law requires promptness in response.

Note what I seek actually from files within the exemption, which it is not, that exemption is not mandatory.

Moreover, I have already been provided with copies of other pictures from the o files on exactly the same subject, by your Department. This alone would seem to invalidate the grounds for this refusal.
