Oswald married Marina Nicholaevna Pruskova, born 7-17-41, on 4-30-61 in Russia. She currently is residing in the Dallas Division and has been interviewed by the Bureau, the last time on 11-28-63.

Preliminary examination of indented writing discloses some figures which possibly might indicate one or more individuals contributed a sum of money totaling \$10, which is being furnished for some undetermined reason, possibly in sympathy with her.

There does not appear to be restrictive reason why this letter cannot be delivered as instructed.
