As you know, with the Attorney General's approval, we are maintaining a technical surveillance on the residence of Marina Oswald. We are also maintaining a microphone surveillance. Both installations were made following a request from the President's Commission that we keep apprised of Marina Oswald's contacts and activities.

ASAC Kyle Clark called 3-4-64 advising that at the present time the Dallas Office was recording the information received from the surveillances. He stated a question had come up as to whether they should keep the tapes or whether it would be permissible to erase them and reuse them.

ASAC Clark was advised that for the time being, at least, the tapes should be maintained and the conversations should not be erased. If this becomes any problem for the Dallas Office, they will be in touch with us further.
