This memorandum recommends the installation of a microphone surveillance at the new residence of Marina Oswald.

It will be noted that Mr. J. Lee Rankin of the President's Commission has expressed concern about the possible contacts of Marina Oswald. We have, accordingly, instituted a discreet physical surveillance and a look-out on the present residence of Mrs. Oswald. It has been determined that she has now rented a house at 629 Beltline Road, Richardson, Texas, to which she expects to move during the coming week end (2-29 to 3-1-64).

We have obtained authority from the Attorney General to institute a technical surveillance on the telephone of Marina Oswald but as of the moment, she has not ordered a telephone to be installed in her new residence.

ASAC K. Clark, Dallas, called this morning to advise that a survey conducted by that office showed that a microphone surveillance could be installed in the residence with full security assured. It is a fact that a microphone surveillance should be most productive in disclosing to us the nature and extent of Marina Oswald's contacts in her residence and through a microphone surveillance we should uncover information which could not be obtained through any other sources.

ACTION:

If you agree, Dallas will be telephonically advised to install a microphone surveillance on the new residence of Marina Oswald based on their assurance that such can be done with full security. When Marina Oswald requests telephone service, we will, of course, immediately institute the technical surveillance which has been authorized.
