responses of the agencies to the Warren Commission, a matter relating to which both the CIA and the FBI have already disclosed a number of records and details. In addition, the subject has received considerable public attention from both Houses of Congress. In my view the FBI has already waived on this by its disclosure of such names, including that of angleton. (The others are within the public domain in any event in the Commission, four and Congressional records.)

There is no need for this withholding, especially not in an historical case, and the matter of coordination, which in some cases assumted to collusion, in itself is of considerable historical importance.
