[REDACTED] NOPD, telephonically contacted this office on 9/14/76 and inquired as to whether or not there was any record in the FBI files in New Orleans concerning the NOPD jacket (file) on OSWALD as they were unable to locate it.

He stated that efforts to locate this record by the NOPD have been unsuccessful and the Superintendent was holding him personally responsible for locating it.

I advised him we would be glad to check and see whether we had any record concerning this.

SA [REDACTED] called [REDACTED] back re OSWALD and advised we don't have any record or ever having obtained the original NOPD record on OSWALD for ourselves or for the Warren Commission (looked all through 89-69 and 100-16601 on OSWALD).

SUPV. [REDACTED] advised [REDACTED] that he may want to contact LSP, since the Warren Commission's source for that NOPD record was the LSP and not the FBI. He was given the Warren Commission citation.

[REDACTED] advised Supv. [REDACTED] that they have the completely reconstructed record but not the original.

[REDACTED] stated it could easily have been misplaced anywhere within NOPD due to the poor record check-out system in effect at that time.

[REDACTED] said he and the Chief only thought of the FBI as one of several other agencies who might have obtained it.
