FOLA appeal

Dear Mr. Shon.

This is my appeal from the dejection of my FOLA request reflected in Director Kelley's letter to me of 11/29/76.

Because you are as devout and practising a stockaller as the FBI I cannot give you the sequential number. You have never acted on my request of a year or so ago or on my appeal of that rejectiob.

What do you do for free information if I can't get a <u>single</u> sequential number? Especially when I saked Director Kelly to use them and he refused.

What kind of "review" do you perform when you see references to what is not provided and do not provide them or a justification for withholding them?

What is withheld by masking is NOF "materials related solely to the internal rules" and practises of the PHI" as the PHI and any reviewing authority knew.

Moreover, as I have already established in court, this withholding is additionally improper and unjustified by ruling of Director Kelley.

I regard this as part of a continuing campaign to demy me my rights under the Act; to maste my time and demy me my rights because errent officialdem does not like my work; and as part of the campaign you spearhead to make the Act unworkable, including bycometing time in men-compliance to fabricate phoney station and to occrload the satire mechanism of compliance, including the courts.

I feel this so strongly that I wris as receipt of Director Kelley's letter.\*

The deliberateness of this stonewalling non-compliance is so obvious I am asking in addition for the names of all who processed and reviewed and searched thise request and all records relevant thereto. My purposes include invoking the pusitive provisions of the Act and preparing to exercisesmy Constitutional rights to patition for a redress of grevances.

For the record I note that Director Kelley's letter does not state that he encloses all records isolated by my request, that he did not and that your review did not result in my receiving all the records required by my request.

I am reminded that it is inscribed ever the main entrance to your building that "The place of justice is a ballowed place" - and that I cannot remember the Last time I did not find that door barred.
