Through reports of interviews and films of two different Oswald literature distributions in New Orleans and by a fingerprint not his of an earlier such picketing the FBI knew of an apparently unidentified Oswald associate (other than Charles Hall Steele, Jr.)

In time the FBI came to claim that this person is identified in the WDSU footage or what remains of it while also having reports that state this person is unidentified. The FBI had copies of still photographs still not produced and never given to the Warren Commission. These photographs were used in an effort to identify this person.

This matter boiled up again with Garrison. When it did New Orleans correctly identified two persons not associated with Oswald in attached 105-82555-5558 as those in the WDSU footage ~~as businessmen with offices in the International Trade Mart.~~ as businessmen with offices in the International Trade Mart.

I provide this copy to eliminate confusion because there are records that indicate that one of these men is the unidentified Oswald associate. Neither was.

In addition, on page three there is indication that this particular Oswald operation included more than him and Steele, thus confirming the earlier reports.
