Serial 3025 and Not Recorded of 3/27/64 from 105-82555 add further information relating to the Director's "brief." This includes its multi-volume size, content that has no relationship with the crime which was never really investigated and thus not briefed, and that "other officials" were provided with copies "by ticklers."

Eleven such officials are listed, identically, on each record.

This again gets to the need to search all the involved Divisions for their copies of pertinent records.

These two ~~records~~<sup>records</sup> which are not attached, are of 3/27 and 4/3/64. In these few days it was found necessary to <sup>twice</sup> update the Director's brief with irrelevant information about the financial situation of Michael ~~and~~ Ruth Paine and with political information relating to their utterly uninvolved relatives.

Even the cover pages were revised and replaced for such irrelevancies.

The fact that the FBI investigated everything but the crimes can account for its present refusal to make obviously necessary searches.
