The attached Domestic Intelligence memo from Section 12B of 62-109060 refers to records I do not recall seeing in any other files, including those provided by New Orleans.

Please note also that insertions of "operational" means that there could have been an other than operational association with the CIA.

In the case of Arcacha, his connection with CIA Cuban activities is reported.

The FBI has records relating to Ferric as a runner of guns to Cuba. It disclosed this under-the-table to a private interest, to my knowledge. It has not disclosed any such records in any of my cases or in response to any requests.

It does not seem that a denial of "any operational interest" requires referral.

But if it did two years have passed.

I err above. The reference should be to Novel, not Ferric.

Novel himself is the source of an alleged CIA connection, whether or not "operational" in description. He appears to have left a note in New Orleans addressed to a CIA person whose name was not common knowledge.
