At 10:15PM today [REDACTED] of [REDACTED] NOLA, no phone, called this office and stated that he had a conversation recently with a WILLIAM THOMAS BOYD about the assassination of the President. [REDACTED] said that BOYD seemed to know of quite a few details of the assassination and that BOYD was an expert with a rifle and sight. According to [REDACTED] BOYD left New Orleans [REDACTED] Greyhound Bus Lines enroute Florence, Alabama. It is not known whether BOYD will stay in Florence or not.

[REDACTED] described BOYD as being from St. Joseph, Tennessee, in his 50's, dark brown hair, wears glasses, color of eyes unknown, 5'9", 165 to 170 lbs.

[REDACTED] at the time of call seemed to be intoxicated. Also advised that he can be reached at [REDACTED]
