Attached are two CIA releases concerning assassination of President matter. In CIA Release No. 84951 CIA asks several questions concerning Oswald, results of interview with him, background data re Mrs. Paine and data re her auto. Answers to these questions must be provided by Nationalities Intelligence and Soviet Sections and also General Investigative Division. Results of Oswald's interview not yet received. CIA Release No. 84950 concerns Sylvia T. Duran, Mexican employee of Cuban Embassy in Mexico, and her contact with Oswald. She and her husband were arrested by Mexican authorities on 11-23-63 for interrogation. She was cooperative and furnished written statements re two visits by Oswald to Cuban Embassy in late September 1963 for purpose of obtaining visa to transit Cuba to go to USSR. Carlos Lechuga, Cuban Ambassador to United Nations and formerly Cuban Ambassador to Mexico, and Duran desire to marry.
