
Dear Mr. Weisberg:

This will acknowledge the receipt by my Office of your letters of August 3, 5 and 12, 1978, which constitute three separate administrative appeals concerning your requests for access to various F.B.I. records pertaining to the assassinations of President Kennedy and Dr. King.

Your appeal regarding the tie worn by President Kennedy at the time of his assassination has been assigned number 8-1656; your appeal concerning the "Byers matter" has been designated 8-1655; and, lastly, your appeal from the failure of the Dallas Field Office to provide you "previously processed" records, as well as requested material concerning Marina Oswald, has been assigned number 8-1657.
