The way things sometimes are in the country and because of the new "efficiency" of the mails I'm not going to take any chances, as I did last night, on the pickups or the delivery and as soon as my wife makes copies I'll take the enclosed comments on the government's brief into town, to the post office, and will send it special delivery.

Last night I had to chase the pickup truck, which was five minutes early getting to the pickup point only two miles away.

I've spoken to Jim about a few things in the case record that ought be available to you and he is going to provide those copies. I have in mind a few more, like this copy of my letter to Shea, that are referred to, like some of the Senate FOIA testimony about the FBI and me, also enclosed.

I'm sending a copy to Jim Lasser in the event you want to discuss any of it with him.

In going over what I wrote I am even more seriously concerned about this newest and netirely baseless assault on me, my integrity and my work and about the cumulative effect of all of this on the courts and others. I do hope you will make a real effort to neutralize the major part of this official poison.
