

Clapp affidavit- records he has not given us

On the second page of this 11/28/72 letter he says they are cataloguing everything for trial, every record of any nature. I have seen no such list or catalogue and if we can obtain records from him I think we want this.

In other ways this is a lawyer's letter for the making of a special record.

Harvey told me about Lewin and said he was anxious to take the case to trial, that in his experience there was no equal of the record of the deliberate abuse of the innocent. When I met Lewin he confirmed this. It is quite the opposite of the pretense that there was a poor chance of collection or proving and quite the opposite of the nature of the settlement under the worst of possible circumstances. This representation, mind you, was when there was no statute of limitations question - the representation is for all the claims. Our settlement for four times this sum and perhaps a little more was based on the last six months, the period of liquidation.
